ASSESSMENT

 A Registered Nurse will perform a detailed clinical evaluation of the patients wound type and assess for best practice wound care, if specified wound orders were not prescribed by physician. Discuss/ Approve wound care treatment with following physician.

HOME SAFETY EVALUATION AND SOC ASSESSMENT

A registered nurse will complete a full SOC assessment with patient and perform the specified wound care treatment or Wound Vac settings as prescribed by following physician. If specified wound orders were not prescribed on initial order, the Registered Nurse will assess the variables of the wound and recommend their best practice method/suggestions for appropriate wound care to prescribing physician. Patients will be educated on their specific disease process, management, interventions, and complications necessitating medical attention. Following nurse will perform approved wound care treatment and update prescribing physician on wound status, size and drainage until wound closure achieved. Following nurse will also assess for signs & symptoms of infection on each follow up visit.

COMPLEX WOUND TREATMENT/STEP-BY-STEP GUIDELINE APPROACH

Complex or chronic wound care treatment plans have a more definitive approach with specialized wound care treatments involved. Patients will be referred to a local Wound Care Clinic that will be actively involved in weekly updates of wound care orders following weekly visits to the wound center by the patient. Patient wounds will be assessed at Wound Care Clinic and appropriate wound care treatments performed to improve wound healing process; i.e. debridement, podiatric assessment, vascular assessment, edema assessment. If patient is unable to travel to a local Wound Care Clinic, the agency works with a Home Visit Wound Care physician who provides similar assessments/treatments in the home setting. The Wound Specialist physician consults with the agency and coordinates & monitors the wound until wound closure accomplished and patient is discharged from further home health services. Our STEP BY STEP patient guides on Pressure Ulcers, Leg Ulcers deliver critical post-acute content, decision support and patient education solutions. It will empower our patients in managing their chronic wound care solutions and significantly improve patient care outcomes in their current home care treatment plan.
